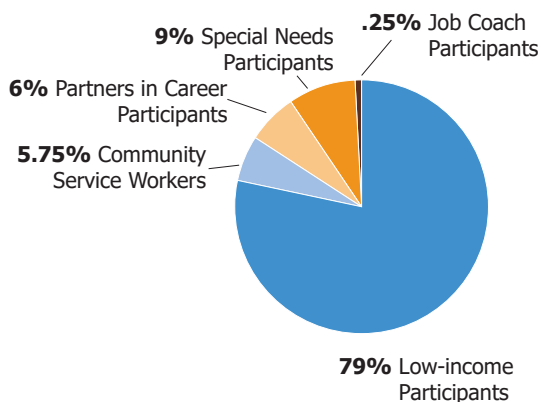


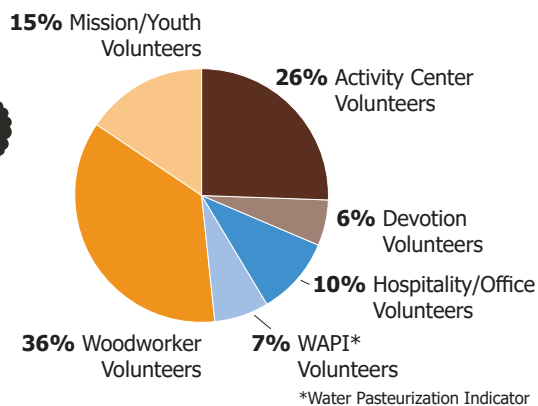


2016 Annual Report—Friends of the Carpenter has been blessed with tremendous growth, with a **31% increase in participant visits** in just the past two years.
