Those seeking respite at Friends of the Carpenter are a diverse and always changing group. The COVID-19 crisis facing our community and the World will adversely affect the lives of our participants, who already faced significant challenges.

We need your financial support! With the unforeseen impact of COVID-19, Friends of the Carpenter had to stop production in our wood shop, local businesses that help support our ministry closed their business, planned events that help generate funding were canceled, and the uncertainty of future impacts has created a greater need.

The programs below depend upon the contributions from our partners and individual donors. Join us and experience God's work through the following opportunities:

- Daily Worship and Devotions from 9:30-10:00 am
- Daily Round Table Activities coupled with facilitated discussions occur throughout every day. These activities are strategically stationed in the Friendship Center that include "Projects with a Purpose", as well as other adult activities designed to increase active participation and spiritual growth.
- Showers are available on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 10:30 am 2:30 pm in our portable showers.
- Wednesday afternoon's "Table Talk Topics" are planned to help engage and strengthen participation from all participants leading to personal growth and spiritual transformation. Table Talk Topics are designed to help participants maneuver through barriers and seek successful choices.

Special financial grants and additional funding sources are being sought for the Pre-Apprenticeship Program. Instructors to deliver the 12-week curriculum, apprentice students and funding for the program are needed to bring the program to fruition. We are hopeful to implement our first offering in the Fall of 2020. The program costs have been estimated at \$55,000.
